Entry Fees: Beauty \$50; Photogenic \$10; Prettiest Smile, Hair, & Eyes \$10; Everything \$60

*Photogenic: 1 unframed 8x10 recent photo per contestant (color or b&w)

*Sibling discount of \$10 per child after full price paid for first child.

Pageant Rules: Beauty wear for girls can be a Sunday dress, flower girl dress, Easter dress, natural type pageant dress, semi-glitz pageant dress, or prom dress.

- For ages 1-9, girls should wear short dresses that may have stones and sequins. Dresses and makeup should be age-appropriate and not overpower the girls. We are looking for a pretty face and personality. Contestants will be judged on personality, poise, and beauty.

** Note, girls 4 and under **MUST** have an adult on stage at all times. You do not have to hold their hand, but you must be close enough to touch them at all times. Contestants 5 & up must walk alone.*

- For ages 10 & up it is very hard to find a dress without a lot of stones, etc. stones will be allowed. Contestants will be judged on modeling, personality, beauty, and poise.

Previous Winners: If you are a previous winner from last year's pageant, you will be unable to compete in this year's pageant in the same age category in which you won. We would like to ask for

previous queens to accompany crowning for this year's pageant if they wish to do so. Please contact the pageant director for questions or concerns.

Awards: There will be one winner in each age group for beauty. The winner will receive a crown, sash, and trophy. There will be two runners-up for each age group. Runners-up will receive a trophy. Best hair, eyes, and smile from each age group will receive a sash. Most photogenic for each age group will receive a trophy.



Score Sheets: All judges' decisions are final! All score sheets are final! Please be sure to send a stamped envelope with your application if you want your score sheets after the pageant. Score sheets are held for 2 weeks after the pageant and are discarded thereafter. Score sheets will be mailed in your envelope and not given out after the pageant!

Pictures: We will have a professional photographer the day of the pageant and packages are available for purchase. Any pictures taken at the pageant will/or may be used for advertisement for future pageants. Contestants will be notified once photos are in and must pick them up from Jackson Town Hall.

Back Stage Chaperones: Each contestant will be allowed 1 chaperone back stage and receive 1 chaperone badge – there are no men allowed in the dressing rooms.

Pageant Admission: \$5 for everyone – children 5 & under are free.

Town of Jackson Christmas Parade: If your contestant wins in the pageant and you wish to put them in the Town of Jackson's Christmas parade, you must **provide your own transportation** and fill out the Town of Jackson's parade application in order to notify the parade director.
